The "Kesen Camellia Dream Project" was founded by two persons, to create new industry and jobs after the disaster. "Ishikawa Oil Refinery", the only camellia oil refinery in Tohoku was hit by the tsunami and decided to close the

business. "Seisho-kan", a handicapped persons employment facity, succeeded the technology of Ishikawa does oil refinery and "Kesen Camellia Hand Cream" was born. "Kesen Camellia Lip Cream" was produced as the second step, and more production to come. Acivities to preserve camellia trees will also begin.



The technology of the Ishikawa oil refinery is inherited.

Mr. Kazutoshi TAKAHASHI of the "Banzai factory" started the noodle-making business, without government subsidy, to help revitalization of the city through creating jobs. Inspired by an idea of using camellia oil by Mr. Oikawa, he has developed and produced "The Starlight Pasta" and "The Camellia Mermaid Cold Noodles", using the camellia oil for sauce and from a seed and husks

Wind Power Personal Windmill

When the Hirota area was isolated by tsunami, Mr. Takahashi realized that electricity is not what to be delivered, but what to be produced on site. So he installed a small wind power unit at his home, another at the factory, to secure power. Not the sunlight panel that cannot respond in winter with few daylight hours but the windmill aims at the securing of electricity of winter.

The Project in the Taya Wooden Temporary Community Center and Temporary Housing in Hirota.

An NPO built a community room for the tentative housing area, then an idea to install a wind power unit to the room came out from the residents. This project has been approved by the Reconstruction Agent, as a pioneer model of "Society with Sustainable Energy, in new Tohoku." More wind power units will be installed in the area."
