# **TOEIC** in Motion – <u>Spring</u> Task

**Task:** Create two dialogues that, when combined, use all the communication strategies taught this semester.

### **OVERVIEW:**

- 1. You will write two dialogues. They can be of any length with any number of characters.
- 2. You may use as few or as many communication strategies in each individual dialogue as you want, but in total all the strategies must be used.
- 3. You may repeat the strategies in both dialogues, and you may use the same strategy multiple times.

### **Details:**

- 2.  $\Box$  Due date: final class day. No Task submitted on time = a grade of <u>ZERO</u> for the Task. Excuses will not be accepted.
- 3.  $\Box$  Early submission = OK. However, once your Task is turned in, <u>you</u> <u>may not resubmit or ask to make changes to it</u>. Submitted Tasks become the property of your instructor.
- 4. All instances of strategy use must be **typed in bold and underlined**.
- 5.  $\Box$  The number of the strategy should be placed in brackets after its use in the dialogue.

Example:

John: Abc def ghi jkl. Mnop qrs. <u>Tuvw xyz</u>. [5]

6.  $\Box$  If an NVC is used, use curly brackets (and type in bold and underline).

Example:

Mary: Abc def ghi. Mnop qrs. Tuvw xyz. {nods} [4]

The Task will be graded on grammar, vocabulary, natural language use, strategy use, and overall Task completion.

## **TOEIC** in Motion – <u>Fall</u> Task

**Task:** Create your own TOEIC Speaking and Writing Tests WITH ANSWERS.

## **OVERVIEW:**

- 1. You will produce the 11 questions on the TOEIC Speaking Test and the 8 questions on the TOEIC Writing Test.
- 2. You will create what the test taker *will see or hear* (in a Microsoft Word document only).
- 3. In the case of test listening areas, you will just type out the text. Do not record any audio. Just type what the test taker would hear.
- 4. Create answers for what would be answers that would receive a perfect rating.

## **Details:**

- 1. The Task must be digitally submitted (either by email or Oh-o! Meiji). If by Oh-o! Meiji, there will be an assignment submission location.
- 2.  $\Box$  Due date: final class day. No Task submitted on time = a grade of <u>ZERO</u> for the Task. Excuses will not be accepted.
- 3.  $\Box$  Early submission = OK. However, once your Task is turned in, <u>you</u> <u>may not resubmit or ask to make changes to it</u>. Submitted Tasks become the property of your instructor.
- 4. □ The Task contents MUST NOT BE copied from other places. That is, you may not copy TOEIC S&W Test material from books, the Internet, etc. You do not necessarily have to create everything from scratch. You may <u>adopt</u> things from other places. However, they MUST conform to the types of questions that are found on the real TOEIC S&W Tests. Tasks that have been copied from TOEIC materials will receive a grade of <u>ZERO</u>.
- 5.  $\Box$  There is no need to write the directions to the tests. You only need to create the actual testing material and answers (after each question).

Hint: imagine that your instructor would take the tests that you create. What questions would your instructor experience?





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
